Jeff made *aliyah* from his native Scotland in 1981 and has since established himself a leader of Israel's nonprofit sector. During the past 25 years, his work focused on securing significant philanthropic contributions, building partnerships, and conducting successful negotiations with Israeli government ministries of finance, defense, housing, education, the Prime Minister's Office, the IDF and others.

For more than a decade, he served as Director General for Resource Development & Public Affairs at the Jewish Agency for Israel. Before joining Ben-Gurion University, he served as Executive Vice President and Director-General of The International Fellowship of Christians and Jews (Keren L'Yedidut). He is the co-founder of *The Israel Academy of Philanthropy*, which has taught dozens of nonprofit professionals in Israel about capacity building, effective philanthropy, and sustainable development. Jeff has an undergraduate degree in psychology from Strathclyde University. He received his teaching certificate from David Yellin College in Jerusalem, and a diploma in education administration from the Hebrew University of Israel.
