Sarah currently represents fifty thousand of her neighbors in the First State Senate District, which includes Claymont, Bellefonte, and parts of Edgemoor and Wilmington. In 2020, she became the first openly trans person in US history elected to serve as a State Senator. If she is elected to Congress, she will be the first openly trans person elected to any federal office.

In the State Senate, she has led the way in proving that small states can do big things.

Sarah led the passage of paid medical and family leave, changing the game for workers and families across the state. She also played a pivotal role in passing critical gun violence laws after Uvalde and has driven key efforts to make healthcare more affordable and accessible.

Sarah worked as an advocate before serving in the State Senate, leading the successful effort to pass landmark non-discrimination protections and championing legislation protecting vulnerable youth from abuse. Sarah grew up in Wilmington and has worked for former Governor Jack Markell, the late Attorney General Beau Biden, in the Obama-Biden White House, and as a national spokesperson for the Human Rights Campaign.
